In closing, we continue to be active especially virtually but also on site at 2315 Cazaville Sideroad.

Two requests have been made to the education department:

1-Set up of a *PumpTrack* (assembled modules to practice such sports as skateboarding, in line skating, bmx biking and also for persons with reduced mobility they could ride this *Pumptrack* with their wheelchairs.

2-Securing the entire site of the CLC by new rink sides, adding netting around the rink to protect the playground and building, adding netting around the baseball field, a fence around the CLC site and all it takes to follow directives of public health such as: plastics on the restaurant side (which will soon open for take out), hand washing machines, etc.

As well, a request will soon be made to the department for the protection of agricultural land (CPTAQ) in order to have part of the CLC property recognized as a place where activities other than agricultural are always held. This would allow the installation of the « Pumptrac » if the request is accepted which would be a new infrastructure on the CLC land.

We follow very closely the new health measures for exterior rinks, you will be informed about the procedure during the winter season if it takes place. Thank you for your understanding.

INSTALLATION OF REFLECTIVE NUMBER SIGNS

NIGHT PARKING

It is **prohibited** to park or immobilize one's vehicle on a public road **between midnight and 6 am** from November 15 to April 15 and this, on the whole of the territory of the Municipality.

STORING FIREWOOD ON A LOT WHERE THERE IS A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING.

Storing of **firewood is allowed on the back and side yards**, the wood must be piled and corded, must not obstruct a door or window and must not be higher that 1.5 meter.



Christmas Tree SAFETY CHECKLIST

- Get a fresh tree whose needles don't easily fall off -or- a UL-Listed artificial tree that is "flame resistant/retardant."
- Place the tree away from heat sources!
- UL-Listed Christmas Lights (Pay attention to Indoor/Outdoor use)
- Check your decor for damage and replace as needed.
- Don't overload your sockets -- no more than 3 light strands in a row.
- Turn off your lights before bed or while you're away from home.
- Dispose of your live tree soon (less than 4 weeks after putting it up) and recycle, don't light it on fire!
- Take down decorations outside sooner to help them last longer. Go ahead and replace decorations that didn't make it by hitting up the after-Christmas sales.




