The municipal council gave a mandate to the ZIP committee to support the modification of the authorization certificate and for the production of a study on the vegetation which is needed for the scything of water plants of five (5) canals. The report of this study will be used for authorization for scything from the environment department and the fight against climate change (MELCC).

Ducks Unlimited Canada has published an excellent article on why we should not feed wild animals such as ducks, swans and snow geese. It is mentioned that even though nature provides an abundance of food needed for their survival, many persons feed them. While this is well-intentioned, it brings about a dependence that can have a negative impact for these animals. Among others, snow geese can produce as much fecal matter in a day as any human, which pollutes the water and produces bacteria toxic to health. It is, therefore, strongly recommended to not feed them. Moreover, fecal matter concentrated in one area can bring filamentous marine algae. Here is the link to Ducks Unlimited Canada ducks.ca.

THE MAYOR PRESENTS THE COST OF THE INTERGENERATION PARK

Do you remember spending afternoons on a swing and going as high as the sky, dreaming of the possibilities of life? Or speeding on your toboggan to reach a friend? Many of you remember fondly a time where life revolved around the playground. It's heart wrenching to think that some children don't know what it is to swing, to slide and to climb in the park with friends.

Parks offer a lot to citizens, to those living nearby and to tourists. More than their numerous environmental advantages, including the preservation of plant and animal habitats, the reduction of air pollution and water filtration, parks create an economic advantage for governments and individuals.

The construction of our intergeneration park always starts with identifying the location, from the municipal friend of seniors plan (MADA). The citizens considered the location and the council took into account these fundamental factors:

Accessibility: is the location accessible in a wheel chair and can it be easily accessible by car or bike? The easier it is to get to the park, the more it will be used. It's important to build inclusive playgrounds where everyone feels welcomed.

Characteristics: is there an historical site and a special zone that can attract visitors to the park for more than just nature? We have used the characteristics of our community's unique history to stimulate traffic in the parks and reinforce community links.

Each project comes down to money. The municipality made a budget. It is important to let you know the cost of the intergeneration park project.

As shown in this report, we realized the park project while attempting to respect the budget presented with a higher expense of \$ 8 720.59.

LARGE ITEM AND ELECTRONICS (ARPE-QUÉBEC) PICKUP



The large item and electronics pickup will be done from October 17 to October 21, 2022. You must place your items the same day as garbage pickup according to the municipal calendar. **(100 lbs/50 kg and less)**

LEAF PICKUP

This pickup will be from September 26 to November 11, 2022. you must place your bags on the same day as garbage pickup. **TAKE NOTE** that from now on, **only the paper bags designed for this purpose will be picked up.**

CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL WASTE SITE (PASS NUMBER MANDATORY)

For 2022, each property can have a free pass for the construction material waste site. This pass is valid for a 4'x8' trailer or a pickup box. To receive this pass, you must call the Town Hall, send an e-mail to communication@stanicet.com or make a request on line at **Voilà!** to get a pass number. Open only on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of each month from 8 am to noon.

MEASURING OF SEPTIC TANK SLUDGE AND SCUM

We foresee measuring septic tank sludge and scum in September. You have until September 6th to register by calling 450 264-2555 or by e-mail at [squenneville@stanicet.com](mailto:squennewille@stanicet.com). The date of the measuring will be set accordingly. We remind you that these septic tank measurements can be done to see if your septic tank needs to be emptied. When the measurements indicate lower than maximum norms, your tank can be emptied the following year when you can request another measurement. The cost of this service is \$50.

GRANTS/TAX CREDIT/INTEREST FREE LOAN

RÉNOCLIMAT: this program is a financial aid for residential renovations that improve the energy efficiency of your home (insulation work, water tightness, replacing windows and doors, installation or replacement of mechanical systems. The information about this program is available on line:

TAX CREDIT FOR MEETING STANDARDS OF SEPTIC INSTALLATION: this tax credit gives financial help to owners and co-owners who have concluded an agreement with a qualified contractor to do work on a septic installation. For more details:


