### **Urban Development**

#### PROCESSING REQUESTS

Take note that we are presently receiving an exceptionally large number of calls, e-mails, requests for permits, certificates and others. For this reason, it is possible that there is a longer than normal delay in processing these requests. However, we are working very hard to maintain a general average delay of aroung two (2) to three(3) weeks. Be sure that we will answer your requests and will follow up on them. Please **do not send more than one message about the same subject** so that we can maintain our productivity, maximize our resources and customer service.

Thank you for your patience and collaboration!

#### WORK IN MIND!

Don't forget to request your permit before starting work. When a permit or certificate is granted, it's because an inspector concluded that the projected work meets the municipal urban development bylaw demands. That is why a request for a permit must be accompanied by the documents necessary for this analysis and that a processing delay is to be foreseen. That is also why **the work cannot begin before said permit is granted, paid and recovered.** The issue of a permit is an authorization to construct or do what is requested and this request must be written, detailed and signed. It's a legal procedure that can seem complicated for some. We offer then a large range of information on our web site under the tab **Service aux citoyens / permis**. If in doubt, contact us. It's also possible to make certain permit requests on line via Voilà.

#### SHORT TERM RENTAL ESTABLISHMENTS

Zoning bylaw 308 allows for short term rental establishments as complementary housing usage under certain conditions. We offer information on line on our web site under the tab **Service aux citoyens** / **permis.** A \$500 fee is required to obtain an occupation certificate which is valid for one (1) year starting on the delivery date. After this delay an occupation certificate must be obtained from the Municipality to continue activities or occupation. Don't forget that in Quebec, according to the law, any cottage, apartment or house rented for 31 days or less must obtain an official registration number from the Corporation de l'industrie touristique du Québec (CITQ).

#### **GRASS CUTTING**

Don't forget that lots must be cut no later that June 1st of each year and that the maximum height of grass or brush is 20 centimetres. After, scything must be done regularly in order to respect the allowed maximum height. This does not apply to cultivated agricultural land or to the protected river bank.

#### **TEMPORARY SHELTERS**

April 15, 2023 is the deadline to remove temporary shelters including the structure.

#### **RETAINING WALL, STABILISATION WORK AND WHARVES**

Take note that for the whole of the province of Quebec, municipalities no longer have jurisdiction to issue permits for retaining walls (cedar post and piled stones). Please note that piled stones forming a stairway are not considered retaining walls. Since the spring of 2022, the department of the Environnement, de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs (MELCCFP) that can issue a ministerial authorization under certain conditions to install a retaining wall. A ministerial authorization is also required for any work to stabilise the river bank for more than 50 metres when plants, bushes are used, for any stabilization work of more than 30 metre when dry materials are used (ex. stones placed in steps), to install a wharf when the property already has one or to install a wharf that is more than 20m2 in area.

#### BAN ON USE OF PESTICIDES AND FERTILIZER ON THE SHORE

Following the adoption of bylaw 478-2, the use of pesticides and fertilizers on the shore is now banned. According to the bylaw, pesticides include all substances or all micro-organisms intended to control, destroy, reduce, attract or repel directly or indirectly a harmful, toxic or a nuisance for humans, flora, fauna, harvests or other properties, or meant to serve as a vegetation growth regulator, excluding medication or vaccines, except if it is topical for exterior use on animals as defined in the law on pesticides. Here are a few examples of these exceptions, use of products for drinking water treatment, pools and secluded artificial lakes, indoor extermination, agricultural uses, in the case of infestations when all alternatives respectful of the environment have failed, etc..
