A word from the mayor

Summer is drawing to a close and I hope you enjoyed it to the fullest. Don't forget that fall is a busy time for agricultural work and beginning of school. I ask that you be doubly careful on our numbered roads, rural roads and especially in school zones.

Here are observations on the seasonal events and the follow-up of some important files

- On January 18, 2017, the Haut-Saint-Laurent MRC asked the engineering firm Stantec Experts-conseils Limitée, to prepare an evaluation study on the safety of the dam and the La Guerre River pumping station. Last June 22, a meeting was held on the action plan of the study. Representatives of the various levels of government were present: the Quebec dams director who represent the Quebec centre of water expertise, the environment minister, the agriculture and fisheries minister, Htdro Quebec, members of the Haut-Saint-Laurent MRC and the mayor of Godmanchester. It must be noted that the owner of the pumping station and the dam is not the Municipality of Saint-Anicet but rather the Haut-Saint-Laurent MRC. The discussion was mostly about the maintenance and operations costs, etc. To be followed.....
- July 13, 2018 we welcomed Ms Isabell Melançon, minister for sustainable development, the environment and the fight against climate change. Numerous subjects were discussed, including the regulatory demands for the safety and reliability of the dams which put great monetary pressure on the Municipality of Saint-Anicet and its citizens, on the administrative management and the financing of La Guerre River, mid and long term aims; the dragging of the canals, the management of rain water, emergency measures and flood plan, wetlands and other projects.
- Congratulations to all the organisations who showed great professionalism during the Corn Festival, la Petite Joyeuse,(bike rally), the history cruise, etc. Great successes! I wish to personally thank the numerous volunteers as well as the entire team of municipal employees who make these events possible.
- We have received from the provincial government an additional \$72,723 for the aid program on local roads. In July we received an additonal \$20,616 for road improvement work on our municipal roads.
- At the council meeting of August 6, Ms Sylvie Tourangeau, district 4 councillor, left her seat. A complaint to the municipal affairs and occupation of the territory department « MAMOT » was lodged concerning the purchase of gas for the municipal vehicles at the service station of the Maissonnette. The expression « conflict of interest » is being said in conversations recently. I can assure you that there is no conflict of interest. We are taking steps with the regional bureau of MAMOT and a meeting is scheduled for August 27, 2018. Ms Sylvie Tourangeau, councillor, you have the trust and support of citizens. To be followed....
- I wish to thank the organizations, small businesses and representatives for the success of our first community show which was held on August 11, 2018, in addition to the great success of the guided tours of the church by Annie Legault which received more than 70 visitors.
- I also wish to underline the importance of getting involved and learning about the way your municipality functions. Come in large numbers, express your opinions at the public consultation of next September 17th for the future of the Municipality of Saint-Anicet!

Don't forget that the key to success is your involvement in the Municipality of Saint-Anicet.



INSPECTOR'S CORNER

Cleanliness of properties and lawn cutting

Please help us keep our municipality clean. The bylaws stipulate that one must see to the tidiness and maintenance of one's lot and the buildings thereon. The fine for not respecting the bylaws is \$400. Don't forget that it is forbidden to let grass and brush grow higher than twenty (20) centimetres. The fine for not respecting this bylaw is \$400.

Fireworks

It is mandatory that you get a permit to have fireworks. To get a free permit you must submit proof that the fireworks will be made by a person with a fireworks maker's certificate or that of an apprentice fireworks maker's certificate, proof of insurance and submit to us the proof that the fireworks were obtained from an authorized fireworks maker and give us the safety measures that will be taken.


