## INSPECTOR'S CORNER

### Night parking

It is prohibited to park or immobilize your vehicle on a public road between midnight and 6 am from November 15 to April 15 on the whole of the territory of the municipality.

### Reminder concerning bylaw #358 aimed at setting up a control system for the cleaning of septic tanks on the territory of the Municipality of Saint-Anicet

According to bylaw #358 septic tanks for residences must be cleaned out at least once (1) every two (2) years for septic tanks used all year long and at least once (1) every four (4) years for septic tanks used seasonally.

Don't forget to give us a copy of the bill from the contractor as proof of the cleaning, this obligation is also indicated in the bylaw.

The minimum fine set in the bylaw for not following these rules is \$500.

### Storing firewood on a lot with a residential building

Storing firewood is allowed in side and back yards. The wood must be piled and stacked, must not block a door or window and must not be more than 1.5 meter high.


