HUNTING SEASON

Hunting season has already begun, for everyone's safety, we wish to remind you that there is an arms bylaw for the whole of the Haut-Saint-Laurent MRC territory. In article 6 of bylaw no. 499, it states that it constitutes a nuisance and is prohibited to use a compressed air firearm, a bow and arrow or a crossbow:

- At less than one hundred (100) metres for any house or building;
- From a public road as well as within an exterior width of ten (10) metres from each side of the road;
- From a fenced pasture containing farm animals, without the permission of the owner.

INSPECTOR'S CORNER

Civic number

For your safety, make sure your civic number is well displayed and visible from the road, night and day.

As per bylaw no. 462, the numbers of your civic number must:

- be 10.16cm (4 in.) high;
- be posted on the face of the main building looking onto the street;
- be of contrasting colour to that of the wall, be visible night and day;
- be posted inside of 3 metres from the public road or from a private road in the case of a building located more than 20 metres from the street.



Temporary shelters

Temporary shelters can now be set up, from now to April 15, 2019. All temporary shelters must be located at a distance of 3 metres from any property line.



Parking of recreational vehicles

Parking of a maximum of 2 different recreational vehicles (example: 1 boat and 1 trailer) is allowed on a lot having a main building.



HALLOWE'EN SAFETY!

In a few days, children will once again be on the streets to take part in the traditional Trick or Treating for Hallowe'en candies. So that the evening is a safe one, the Sûreté du Québec reminds you of some safety rules. First it's important to be sufficiently visible since numerous pedestrians, drivers and cyclists will be on the road at a time when visibility is reduced. During the evening, children should always:

- * Set up a route and an arrival time with their parents;
- * Remain in a group or with an accompanying adult;
- * Never go in a stranger's house or car;
- * Never follow a stranger, whether he be in a car or on foot;
- * Cross the streets at intersections;
- * Travel one side of the street at a time.



In addition, the police asks for drivers' collaboration, that they be particularly careful and travel at a reduced speed, by giving priority to the children on the streets. Volunteer firemen will be present in the villages of Cazaville and Saint-Anicet.



- . Olive or canola oil
- . Canned fruits and vegetables
- . Dried fruits (ex : raisins, dried cranberries)
- . 100% pure fruit juice and vegetable juice
- . Tomato or pasta sauce
- . Canned fish (tuna, salmon, sardines), flaked chicken or ham
- . Legumes, beans, peanut or almond butter, nuts, grains
- . UHT milk, powdered milk, enriched soy drinks, evaporated milk, nutritional drinks (ex. Boost, Ensure)
- . Vegetable, chicken or beef broth, ideally low in sodium
