



We have done an analysis for you and we are presenting this comparative chart for the years 2013 to 2018. Municipal taxes are usually calculated by multiplying the rate of taxation by the municipal valuation and then divided by 100. Thus, a property valued at \$231,291, (average valuation of a residence on the Saint-Anicet territory) and having a rate of taxation of \$0,5480 will receive a 2018 municipal tax bill of **\$1,267.47** (231,291 x 0,5480 divided by 100) in addition to the taxes such as garbage pickup, community centre, library, since these are fixed amounts that do not take the property valuation into account.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Ashes can remain hot up to 7 days and continue to produce carbon monoxide. In Quebec, approximately one fire every two days is caused by the wrong disposal of hot ashes. Place them in a metal container with a raised bottom and a lid, then place this outside on an incombustible surface at more than a meter from a building. You can also add water or snow to cool them.

**SNOWMOBILE, ATV, ETC...**

Please note that it is strictly prohibited to travel outside of marked paths for all off road vehicles. IN CASE OF BREACH TO THE HIGHWAY CODE OR TO THE LAW REGULATING OFF ROAD VEHICLES, offenders risk: a fine and inaptitude points.

**AGRICULTURE PORTRAIT**

There are 47 family farms in St-Anicet. There are dairy farms, beef, pork and goat production and dairy sheep. As to crops, cereals such as corn, soy, wheat and hay are used in human or animal consumption. Small fruits, vegetable and ornamental horticulture completes the landscape. Numerous businesses are open to the public: agritourism, U-pick, processing on the farm, sale in local markets, centralized sales through cooperative marketing. In all cases, the businesses are regulated by the norms of bio-safety, health and hygiene, quality, animal well-being and protection of the environment. The St-Anicet agricultural zone covers 92.2% of its territory, that is 12,482 hectares, which is an important factor in the strong feeling of belonging to their region felt by farmers. 94% of businesses employ family members and this, for many generations. The average age of producers is 51. However, in the Haut-Saint-Laurent MRC, it's in St-Anicet that there is more succession under 40 years old, living on the farm.
