BE READY FOR 72 HOURS

Since 2019, the municipality has put in place an official emergency plan. This plan gives precise instructions to face any natural or technological catastrophe. As well, it ensures the safety of citizens and proposes an efficient guide of directives to engage in a complete emergency plan, in collaboration with emergency personnel, community partners and the public.

In the event of a major catastrophe, the emergency and municipal personnel must respond to the immediate needs of the population affected. It is, therefore, important to be ready to take care of you and your family at least 72 hours in the case of interruption of essential services. The tools, the information and the resources available in an emergency plan proposes steps that you can follow to prepare and reduce the stress and the impact of a major emergency on yourself and your family.

We can all collaborate to be proud of our community

The successful preservation of Lake Saint-François depends on the small and large actions of each community living by the Great Lakes, the Saint-Laurent river or North American rivers. As vice-president of the « Alliance des villes des Grands Lacs et du Saint-Laurent », I have had the opportunity to participate in the international conference of the Alliance of Canadian and American mayors and politicians in Washington DC. In spite of the progress seen on both sides of the border as to the involvement of governments in the matter of water quality, of infrastructures to preserve the embankments, we need an even greater leadership to meet the challenges that persist. In Canada the members of the Alliance continue to pressure the federal government so that it invests and protect the cities' access to safe and clean water and ensure our capability to adapt to climate changes all the while meeting the needs of a growing population.

2023 Tax bill

Your tax bill is now available on line!

Beginning in 2024, your tax bill will no longer be sent by e-mail. We, therefore, invite you to register to the citizen portal service **Voilà!** which will give you access to numerous services such as your annual tax bill and this, no matter where you are. **Without your registration you will receive your tax bill by MAIL ONLY.**

When you register, don't forget to **complete the section « propriété »** in order to add your tax bill.

If you need help to register, don't hesitate to call us at 450 264-2555, we will be glad to help you register.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

We ask that you choose one of the following methods of payment* :

- **On line** through your financial institution: stanicet.com/services-en-ligne;
- **By cheque**, by mail or in the mail box located to the left of the main entrance to the Town Hall (335 Jules-Léger Avenue);
- **By credit card** through Accéo stanicet.com/services-en-ligne (Accéo charges a 1.98% fee);
- **In person** at the Town Hall, in **cash**, by **cheque** or **debit card** Monday to Thursday from 9 am to 4:30 pm (335 Jules-Léger Avenue)

If your tax bill is lower than \$300, you must pay the total amount in one payment no later than March 15. If it is equal or superior to \$300, you can pay it in 4 payments.

SOUTHWEST MUTUAL AID PROJECT FOR RADIO COMMUNICATIONS TOWER

Southwest Quebec Mutual Aid Association is a non-profit organization that groups the fire safety resources of the region. The Association plans the construction of a free-standing steel tower ,30 metres high to solve an important communication problem. The perimeter of the site will be fenced in order to limit access to the public.

In order to meet the public consultation criteria established by Innovation, Science and Economic development Canada, the Mutual Aid Association invites the public to send its comments on the proposed location before April 1, 2023. This tower conforms to the directives of Industry Canada included in the procedure decree concerning clients CPC-2-0-03.

SNOW REMOVAL

This winter, lets help our snow removal crew make our roads safe:

- If possible, place your bin on the street the morning of the pick up;
- Shovel the snow on your lot instead of pushing it on the street or on the sidewalk which is illegal;
- Respect the no parking in the streets at night (between midnight and 6 am, until April 15).

The equipment is large and snow can be pushed far. One must be cautious when they go by by staying far from the street, especially if you are walking. To be efficient, this equipment must travel between 30 and 40 km/h. Be patient if you are behind them!

Removing snow banks left behind by municipal snow removal (or its representatives) in driveways or parking lots is the responsibility of citizens, no matter the height, width or its condition.

IMPORTANT

Citizens who use public roads to spread the snow to make it melt faster cause safety problems for users. Whoever contravenes article 10 of bylaw 478 is committing an infraction and is liable to a fine. Each year, accidents occur because of snow removal badly done by citizens or contractors who leave snow on the roads or sidewalks.



Golf Club



It is taught **for free** and can be done alone or in a group.


