



## SNOW REMOVAL

**Did you know that...**

1– For efficient snow removal, a snow plow can only go a maximum of 50 km/hr? To go any faster would affect the quality of the work since the snow that is lifted can fall on the road behind the vehicle.

2– The maximum speed to spread abrasives is 40 km/hr? Spreading at a greater speed disperses the abrasive on too large a surface and reduces its efficiency.

# INSPECTOR'S CORNER

# FIRE DEPARTMENT

## PERMITS CERTIFICATES

Whether it be for the construction, demolition, development, work on the edge of a water course and other, getting a permit or a certificate can be required. Small or large project, certain norms must be respected. Before investing in getting work done, it is recommended that you consult the urban development service. This simple step can make any construction or renovation project correct and inform you on the need or not to get a permit or authorization certificate. In order to avoid an unnecessary trip, we suggest calling for an appointment or call the inspector.

We recommend that you plan your projects in advance since the required delay for the analysis of a request can vary depending on the number of requests. The bylaw on permits and certificates indicates a maximum delay of 30 days from the date the request is received whether it be to give the permit or certificate or its refusal.

## SNOW AND ICE

Is prohibited the disposal of snow or ice coming from a private property onto the street or any other public place. (Nuisance bylaw #478, article #10)

## DOGS

A new provincial law concerning the application of the Law to protect persons by setting up a framework concerning dogs is planned for next March 3rd.


This law will be enforced by the municipalities. The 3 objectives of the bylaw is to make an inventory of the dogs and the wounds, prevention and act when needed. The bylaw asks the municipalities to establish annual registration fees and to keep an up to date registry of all dogs on its territory, to manage potentially dangerous dogs and this as part of other obligations. The bylaw allows us to delegate the enforcement of the bylaw to an organization (in part or in its entirety) and because of this the council has given the animal control to SPCA Refuge Monani-Mo for 2020. Moreover, the bylaw contains general norms for all dogs and should be consulted by all dog owners. The bylaw does not contains norms for forbidden dog breeds and can be consulted on line:






