1. The following seats are open for nominations: MAYOR AND COUNCILLORS of districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.
2. Every nomination paper for these seats shall be filled at the office of the returning officer to receive nomination papers, if necessary, on the following days and times:

FROM SEPTEMBER 17TH TO OCTOBER 1ST, 2021

Monday to Thursday from 9 am to noon and from 1 to 4:30 pm
Friday from 9 am to 12 Am

NOTE—On Friday, October 1st, 2021, the office will be open with no interruption from 9 am to 4:30 pm.

3. If more than one candidate applies for the same seat, an election will be held on: November 7rd, 2021 from **9:30 am to 8 pm.**

And an advanced poll will be held on:

October 30th, 2021 from **9:30 am to 8 pm.**

October 31th, 2021 from **9:30 am to 8 pm.**

Municipal election November 7rd, 2021

THE ELECTORAL PROCEDURE

Throughout Quebec, **2021** is a **general election** year. The office of the mayor and all the councillor seats are open for elections.

Persons who wish to become candidates to a council seat can obtain the form “**Nomination paper**” at the office of the Municipality during regular business hours. The timeline to present the nomination paper will be from **September 17th to October 1st, 2021 at 4:30 pm according to the schedule established in the public notice.** The required criteria to become a candidate are described further in the communiqué.

The **electoral list will be drawn** from September 17th to October 8th, 2021 from the data sent by the chief returning officer of Quebec and will be added to that list, property owners who are non-residents and who have requested to be included on that list.

If an election is necessary, **the electoral list will be revised** October 19th from 9:00 am to 12: am and from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm and October 21th, 2021 from 7:00 pm to 10:00 pm.

The **advanced poll** will take place October 30th and October 31th 2021 and will be open from 9:30 am to 8:00 pm at the Council Hall, at 333 Jules Léger Avenue in Saint-Anicet.

On **voting day**, November 7rd, 2021, the poll will be open from 9:30 am to 8:00 pm. You will be notified as to the place of the polling station when the notice of election is published in October 2021.

We remind you that in order to vote you must **identify** yourself by presenting one of the following documents:

- driver’s license,
- health insurance card,
- passport.

Voting in municipal elections is contributing to your community

CANDIDATE POR MAYOR OR COUNCILLOR

Conditions are established in order to run as candidate for municipal mayor or councillor. Some of these conditions touch on the person's status, others are related to ineligibilities.

To be eligible to become a member of council, all persons must:

1. Have the right to be registered on the municipal electoral list (does not mean that one must be registered on the list) that is, to meet the following requirements:
 - On September 1st, 2021:
 - ⇒ Be a natural person;
 - ⇒ Be a Canadian citizen;
 - ⇒ Not be under trusteeship nor in any case of ineligibility set out by law::
 - AND**
 - ⇒ Meet one of the two following conditions:
 1. Be domiciled in the territory of the municipality, and for at least six months, in Quebec;
 2. Be, since at least twelve months:
 - ◇ Owner of an immovable, or
 - ◇ Sole occupant of a business establishment
 - Be 18 years of age on voting day, that is November 7rd, 2021;
2. In addition, reside in the territory of the municipality for at least twelve months on September 1st, 2021, in a continuous manner or not.

To present a nomination paper:

For the municipal elections that will be held on **November 7rd, 2021**, voters who wish to become candidates, have from September 17th to October 1st, 2021 at 4:30 pm, Monday to Thursday from 9 am to 12 pm and 1 pm to 4 pm and Friday from 9 am to 12 am to present their nomination paper at:

REQUIREMENT TO BE A VOTER

The requirements to be a voter are as follows:

- September 1st, 2021 of the general election year is the date that the requirement to be an elector must be met, that is:
 - ⇒ Be a natural person;
 - ⇒ Be a Canadian citizen;
 - ⇒ Not be in any case of ineligibility set out by law (under trusteeship or guilty of an offence that constitutes a corrupt electoral practice);
- AND
 - ⇒ Meet one of the two following conditions:
 1. Be domiciled in the territory of the municipality and for at least six months in Quebec;
 2. Be since at least twelve months:
 - ◇ Owner of an immovable;
 - ◇ Sole occupant of a business establishment;
- Be 18 years of age on voting day, that is, November 7rd, 2021;
- In addition, one registration is permitted for the owner of numerous properties in the municipality;
- The sole owner who is not domiciled must forward to the municipality a signed request to be registered on the electoral list before October 3th, 2021;
- The undivided co-owner who is not domiciled must forward to the municipality a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners who are eligible to vote before October 3th, 2021.
